



**CORRIGENDUM**

In partial modification of Recruitment Notice dated 12/02/2019, the following amendments are made:

1. The word '**Matriculation**' stands omitted under the qualifications mentioned for the post of 06/18 (Sr. Radiographer) and 15/18 (Jr. Radiographer)
2. The pay scale for the post of Administrative officer (18/18) may be read as **Rs. 9300-34800 with GP 4800 (Level-8)** in place of Rs. 15600-39100 with GP 5400 (Level-10).
3. As per RRs notified for the post of Pharmacist in Delhi Gazette on 30/03/2019, **the maximum age limit is 27 years** in place of 30 years and the educational qualifications for the post of Pharmacist may be read as under:-
  - Bachelor degree in Pharmacy (B.Pharm) from a recognized University or equivalent; and
  - Registered as Pharmacist under the Pharmacy Act, 1948.
  - The selected candidate has to be registered in Delhi Pharmacy council within six months of joining."
4. For the post of Public Relations officer, the educational qualifications may be read as under:
  - Degree from a recognized university or equivalent
  - Degree or Diploma in public relations/publicity/journalism from a recognized university or equivalent.
  - 03 years experience of working in Public Relations Department/Newspaper or News agency or 03 years experience of Publicity in a Govt. Deptt or a commercial publicity organization.

**OR**

03 years experience of working as a social worker in a Govt. Medical Institution.

**Desirable:**


- (i) Masters degree of a recognized university or equivalent
  - (ii) Knowledge of Hindi.
5. 01 post of UR under the category of Nursing Officer reserved for **Acid Attack Victims** in place of 04 (UR)-OL category and rest 03 shall be reserved for (UR)-OL.

**Note:** The number of vacancies being mentioned against UR category are subject to notified as per EWS (10%) reservation criteria in view of DoPT OM dated 31/01/2019 on reservation for Economically weaker sections (EWSs), endorsed vide D.O no. 36039/1/2019-Estt.(Res.) dated 20/02/2019 from Additional Secretary, DoP&T, Govt. of India and further endorsed by Govt. of India, Ministry of Home Affairs vide letter No. 14012/06/2019-Delhi-I dated 14/05/2019."
